Celebrating World Water Day Today – March 22, 2021

It is time to begin our new fiscal year. It seemed appropriate to send out this newsletter on World Water Day and give you some updates. Some clubs have already sent World Gardening contributions.

Water for South Sudan

As of the first of March, Water for South Sudan has drilled 21 new wells working towards their goal of 40 for the season. They have rehabbed 32 of the 50 wells they had planned to rehab with new and better cement and design. They are moving along with their goals of drilling, rehabbing and teaching about hygiene and Covid safety steps wherever they go.

Dig Deep

The Navajo Water Project continues to make clean water more accessible to the Navajos by extending water lines and providing 250 gallon containers that can be filled for individual homes. They have also expanded to Appalachia – McDowell County, West Virginia due to contaminated water from the mines and 100 year old pipes, many families don't have clean water. They are helping to bring fresh water to the families there.

You can choose by just putting the words - *Water for South Sudan or DigDeep* on the memo line of your check. **If you want to give to both organizations, you will have to write two checks.** All of this *hope for the future* is helped by us.
